AN ORDINANCE REJECTING A TENTATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY, AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, LOCAL 1002.

WHEREAS, a tentative agreement has been proposed between the administration and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Ohio Council 8, Local 1002; and,

WHEREAS, Council determines, in light of the current public health crisis in the entire country surrounding the COVID-19 (corona) virus, that serious question exists as to the impact of the applicability of one or more provisions of the tentative agreement as they relate to the existence and duration of the COVID-19 public health crisis, and that this uncertainty creates the potential for significant negative operational and financial impacts and burdens to the operation of city government, and therefore the proposed tentative agreement is not in the best interests of the City, in its present form; and,

WHEREAS, this ordinance is necessary because of the immediate need to reject said tentative agreement, and that in order to preserve the public peace, property, health, welfare and safety of the community, and to provide for the effective operation of the municipal government, and by reason thereof, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage; **Now, Therefore,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LIMA, OHIO, WITH AT LEAST A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

Section 1. The tentative collective bargaining agreement proposed between the City and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Ohio Council 8, Local 1002, is hereby rejected in its entirety.

Section 2. The Auditor is authorized to account for the activity authorized herein as is appropriate under the circumstances of this ordinance and in accordance with City policies and procedures, or as otherwise required by law.

Section 3. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings held in compliance with the law.

Section 4. The Clerk of the Council be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to cause publication of this ordinance to be made in a summary manner as provided by the City Charter.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force forthwith upon passage by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members elected to council at the first reading hereof. If it shall not so pass it shall take effect and be in force forthwith upon passage by an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members elected to council at the second reading hereof. If it shall not so pass at second reading then it shall take effect and be in force forthwith upon passage by an affirmative vote of at least a majority of the members elected to council at the third reading hereof. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
