**Whereas:**

Every year thousands of American workers are killed by workplace injuries and occupational disease; and

**WHEREAS:** Forty years ago, Congress passed the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) promising every worker the right to a safe job in the United States; and

**WHEREAS:** The toll of workplace injuries, illnesses and death remains enormous; and

**WHEREAS:** Concerned Americans are determined to prevent these tragedies by:

Observing Workers' Memorial day on April 28, as a day to remember these victims of workplace injuries and disease;

Renewing our efforts to seek stronger safety and health protections, better standards and enforcement, and fair and just compensation;

Rededicating ourselves to improving safety and health in every American workplace.


**NOW THEREFORE:** I, David J. Berger, Mayor of the City of Lima, Ohio, do hereby proclaim April 28<sup>th</sup> as

**WORKERS' MEMORIAL DAY**

in Lima, Ohio, in recognition of workers killed, injured and disabled on the job.
