WHEREAS: A stronger community flourishes where employers and workers establish long-term relationships based on dignity, respect and mutual trust through healthy collective bargaining; and


WHEREAS: The quality of the environment, public education, social network and infrastructure of our community is enhanced as a result of the presence of union families and their unions.
