# Proclamation

## Whereas:

Lima-Allen County Paramedics (LACP) was founded as Lima Ambulance Service on March 1, 1964, taking over services provided by funeral home ambulances, to serve those in need of medical care and transportation; and

**WHEREAS:** LACP currently employs 70 full-time equivalent employees, operates nine ambulances, with total fleet of 15 vehicles. In 2013 LACP responded to more than 20,000 calls for service and transported nearly 19,000 patients; and

**WHEREAS:** LACP, a leader in medical transportation services, provides ambulance service at community festivals and sporting events and community education, including CPR; and

**WHEREAS:** LACP was purchased by St. Rita's Medical Center in 2008 and in 2010 moved in to a newly built facility with a state-of-the-art dispatch center and more space for vehicle maintenance; and


**WHEREAS:** LACP is proud to celebrate 50 years of service to Lima and the region, and in partnership with St. Rita's Medical Center is committed to the mission of providing the Lima community with compassionate care and the highest level of medical transportation services, and skilled medical personnel.
