Whereas:

Forty two years ago, Helen Mack brought to the Lima community the borrowed idea of offering one another Christmas wishes before rows of decorated evergreens and thus was born the Christmas Tree Festival; and

WHEREAS: Fifty-three trees were sponsored in the first year by various groups and individuals and in one week 3,500 people visited the Allen County Museum to view the trees; and

WHEREAS: In 2013, ninety-one trees were sponsored and the festival was attended by more than 20,000 people; and

WHEREAS: The Christmas Tree Festival offers evergreens of every interest, and most especially for children there is "Evergreen", the Talking Tree, which emphasizes to them the purity of Christmas; and

WHEREAS: The theme for 2014 Christmas Tree Festival is "All I Want For Christmas"; and


