Proclamation

Whereas:

Mr. Roy C. Warnock was born in Edmonton, Alberta Canada, attended Ardrossan Elementary and High Schools, and holds a Bachelor of Science degree with distinction from the University of Alberta in Chemical Engineering in 1973. He is a member of the Association of Professional Engineering, Geologists and Geophysicists of Alberta (AEPGA), and the Association of Professional Engineers and Geologists of Saskatchewan; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Roy C. Warnock has been an associate of the Calgary-headquartered Husky Energy Corporation since 1983 and is currently the Vice President – U.S. Refining based in Lima, Ohio at the Lima Refining Company; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Warnock joined Husky Energy Inc. in 1983 as Technical Services Manager of the Prince George Refinery. Since that time he has fulfilled positions of progressive responsibility, including Manager of the Prince George Refinery from 1988 to 1998. In 1998 Mr. Warnock was appointed Manager of the Lloydminster Upgrader, and in 2001 became General Manager of both the Lloydminster Upgrader and the Lloydminster Refinery; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Warnock served as Vice President, Upgrading and Refining from 2002 to 2007. While in that position he was responsible for the operations of the Lloydminster Refinery, Lloydminster Upgrader, Lloydminster Meridian Cogeneration Facility, Prince George Refinery and the Lloydminster and Minnedosa ethanol plants. His focus was on the safe operation and the optimization of each facility, including occupational and process safety, cost management, project initiation and execution, and revenue enhancement; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Warnock was appointed Vice President & General Manager of the Lima Refining Company in July 2007 when Husky Energy Inc. purchased the Lima Refinery, successfully bringing the Lima Refinery in line with Husky's high standards of safety, production, human resources and community involvement. As Vice President, U.S. Refining, Mr. Warnock was responsible for all refining operations in the United States and worked tirelessly to achieve the goal of refining Husky's western Canadian production in the U.S. a reality; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Warnock's career at Husky has touched nearly every aspect of the company's Downstream operations. From his first days at Husky as Technical Services Manager of the Prince George Refinery in 1983, Mr. Warnock has been an invaluable contributor to Husky's success; and

WHEREAS: Through his efforts, Husky Energy Downstream operations have grown into a stable foundation for the company, and he leaves a legacy of exemplary work in building organizations of people and facilities that are a credit to Husky Energy; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Warnock is retiring September, 4, 2015 and will enjoy his time with his wife Janeen, their three children, son Scott and his wife Michelle, grandchildren, Rome, Ava, Griffin and Carter, son Ryan and his wife Pretti, grandchildren Tanner and Olivia, and daughter Erin and her husband Derek and grandson Brady.


NOW THEREFORE:
