# Proclamation

## Whereas:

On November 10, 1775, a force of two battalions of Marines was authorized by the Continental Congress and later a corps of Marines was established by the U. S. Congress on July 11, 1798; and

**WHEREAS:**

The U.S. Marine Corps played important roles, during the 19th Century, in the War of 1812, the Mexican War, the American Civil War, the Spanish-American War, and the Boxer Rebellion; and

**WHEREAS:**

During World War I (1914-1918) artillery and aviation units were added to the Corps, and the brave efforts of the 4th Marine Brigade in the Battle of Belleau Wood brought the Marine Corps worldwide fame; and

**WHEREAS:**

During World War II (1939-1945) the Marine Corps grew to a peak of 669,100 troops who fought gallantly in all of the Pacific campaigns notably Guadalcanal, Iwo Jima, and Okinawa, and the Corps was also active in the Korean War (1950 - 1953) and the Vietnam War (1959-1975), and is now playing a critical role in our nation's international fight against terrorism; and

**WHEREAS:**

Marines are trained and equipped primarily to carry out integrated land, sea, and air operations; and

**WHEREAS:**

The Marine Corps Women's Reserve was established during World War I, reinstated during World War II and in 1948, under the Armed Forces Integration Act was established as a permanent component of the Corps.


**NOW THEREFORE:**
