## Seven Lima Businesses Named *Stormwater Superstars*

Seven Lima businesses and organizations are being honored as 2018 Stormwater Superstars. This distinction recognizes a variety of efforts and practices from the individual businesses that each have an impact on stormwater runoff and ultimately a clean and healthy Ottawa River. The following are being honored in this second annual local showcase:

**4D Imaging** is being recognized for efforts in waste management, reduction and recycling.

**Allied Environmental Services, Inc.** is being recognized for stormwater protection and community pride through their participation in Lima's Adopt a Roadway program.

**Black Lace Hair Salon** is reducing stormwater runoff by replacing a 3300 square foot impervious asphalt surface with a grass lawn, allowing rainfall to filter naturally through the soil.

**Crankers Cycling** has an impressive attitude towards recycling of all waste materials including aluminum, plastic, paper, cardboard, and even brass fittings from inner tubes.

**FITS Lawn Care and Landscaping** takes exceptional care to insure minimal stormwater impact, with emphasis on the use of organic materials.

**Quick As A Wink Printing** is being recognized for efforts in waste reduction and recycling.

**Restoration House of Lima** contributes to protecting stormwater through the training and ethic they pass on to 40 residents regarding pride in home maintenance, green space care, gardening, recycling, and litter prevention.

The *Stormwater Superstar* recognition is a joint project between the City of Lima Stormwater Department and Allen Soil and Water Conservation District and is designed to be an annual showcase. To date, 17 local businesses have been honored.
