Whereas:

The *Trinity* Sculpture was dedicated to the City of Lima 35 years ago; and

WHEREAS: Susan Cole Urano and Ellen Nelson, Executive Directors of The Lima Art Association, began the task to give the Lima community a landmark contemporary public sculpture 37 years ago; and

WHEREAS: The Lima Art Association directors and leadership committee announced an all-call for artists nationwide, and selected Stuart Fink as the artist to complete a work of art that reflected our city; and

WHEREAS: Susan and Ellen worked with the artist, schools, and community partners for two years to create the contemporary public sculpture on the northwest quadrant of Town Square, called *Trinity* and dedicated it to the city in 1987; and

WHEREAS: Their vision and passionate work for the arts has cultivated a rich artistic legacy for others to model. Their leadership has shown how a diverse town can come together and achieve great accomplishments for all. When viewing the 'Trinity' sculpture, we rest in the knowledge that our artistic plans can be achieved, bringing beauty and sophistication to our city, and serving as an inspiration to the future generations of artists and creative thinkers.


NOW THEREFORE: I, David J. Berger, Mayor of the City of Lima, Ohio, do hereby proclaim June 29th, 2021, as
