## What is the purpose of the organization?

The goal of the Ottawa River Coalition (ORC) is to help educate the public about the importance of the river as a natural resource and how everyone can protect the primary source of their drinking water by understanding the sources of contamination and pollution and then actively participating in methods to minimize the amount of pollutants that enter the watershed.

The ORC began its formal membership in 1994. Members, partners and other volunteers represent many facets of industry, agencies, agriculture, business, engineering, organizations, municipalities and political subdivisions who are actively engaged in the protection and restoration of the watershed where they live and work.

#### How do you carry out your program?

The ORC meets together with all its committee members on a bi-monthly basis.
