Whereas:

Mr. Ken Heath is celebrating 50 years in education and his 30th year at Temple Christian School; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Heath knew, by the time he was in high school, God was leading him to be an educator; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Heath has established a countless number of relationships with the students, staff members, and families of Temple Christian School and is truly loved and appreciated for his servant's heart, faithful service and the selfless sacrifices he has made.


NOW THEREFORE: I, David J. Berger, Mayor of the City of Lima, Ohio, do hereby proclaim Sunday, May 5, 2013 as
