Limits

All emergency repairs must be necessary for the health and safety of the occupants of the home. The program is available to residents of the City of Lima who are unable to pay for repairs to their homes.

Eligible

- hazardous or non-operational electric service
- blocked or broken sewer lateral
- leaking gas lines or main
- broken water service line
- leaking roof (limited to area)
- severe leaking water or drain lines
- severely damaged window/door
- inoperable water heater
- visible hazardous wiring or components
- hazardous floor/wall/ceiling areas
- improperly vented fuel-burning appliances
- non-operational toilet
