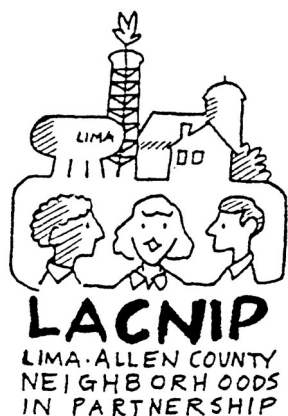

Proposed Changes to Lima City Water Ordinance

Public is invited to attend the next Lima City Council Utilities Committee meeting scheduled for:

Monday, September 20 at 6:00pm
in the Council Conference Room at 50 Town Square.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the proposed change in the City of Lima Codified Ordinance Section 1044.03 that refers to the tenants or other groups being able to have the bill in their name.

Section 1044.03 clearly states that the owner of the real estate is liable for all water and service charges, and it is being proposed that any reference of "other entity" is removed from the language of the ordinance.

All citizens need to be aware of and involved in the discussions to make sure Lima City Council hears a wide variety of comments and suggestions before making a decision on this issue.

Exercise your right as a citizen, and make your voice heard.

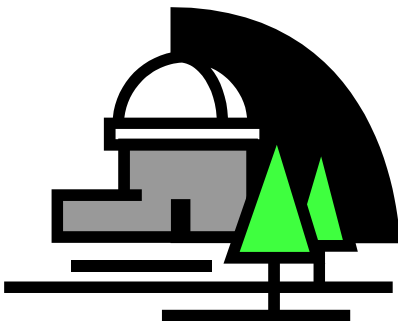
