

**Community Stakeholder – Theme 2**  
**Education and Training Committee Meeting**  
**March 5, 2009**

**Welcome:** The meeting was held on March 4, 2009 from 4 – 5 p.m. in the Café Conference Room at St. Rita’s Medical Center’s. Walt Kinsey welcomed committee members and new members were introduced.

Tony Geiger, Paul Nardini and Walt Kinsey met prior agreed that a consolidation of the goals be discussed at this meeting. Concluding results were:

**Priority#1:** Educate the public and law enforcement of issues.

**Priority #2:** Educate the public as to the court systems.

**Priority #3:** Community participation.

By narrowing the goals, we will have more direct and result driven committee. Talking Points include:

- To have a City “Gatekeeper” appointed for news releases either by The Lima News, Radio, Fox or NBC television, etc. so that a clear message of concerning questions could be answered be of various media transmissions.
- Top questions and educational concerns could be bi-monthly or monthly as needed
- The Cincinnati Citizen Complaint Authority Form was distributed for discussion. At this time, the committee felt we were not ready for this type of communication until we have further developed our processes to meet Lima’s needs. We will need to intergrade the format with other committee chairpersons.
