Applications will be made available on the City's website at www.cityhall.lima.oh.us on the Department of Community Development's Five-Year Consolidated Plan page. Non-profit groups and other entities can apply to receive funding for projects and services meeting CDBG and HOME criteria pursuant to HUD regulations. To be eligible, a program or project must meet a HUD National Objective and the applicant must demonstrate how the program or project primarily benefits targeted groups or areas and how they will comply with HUD regulations and guidelines. When reviewing applications for funding, the City will consider the specific benefit to the Lima community in accordance with the priority needs and program goals established by the City of Lima Five-Year Consolidated Plan, among other criteria including federal regulations.
